



United Way Self-Sufficiency Common Measures

EDUCATION/ JOB TRAINING

GOAL: Every Child Enters Kindergarten Ready to Learn

0-3 Milestones – % of children meeting developmental benchmarks

Kindergarten Readiness – % of students assessed as K-ready academically and social emotionally

GOAL: Every Child Succeeds Academically Through Support In and Out of School

Early Reading – % of 3rd graders proficient at reading on Iowa Assessments

Middle Math – % of 8th graders proficient at math on Iowa Assessments

Social Emotional Learning – PENDING

GOAL: Every Student Graduates from High School Prepared for Post-secondary Education or Career Training

High School Graduation – % of students who graduate in 4 years and 5 years

Post-secondary Enrollment – % of students who enroll in a post-secondary institution within 12 months of graduation

GOAL: Every Adult Has the Education, Training, and Skills to Obtain a Career That Can Sustain a Family

Post-secondary Completion – % of post-secondary attainment in the county

Employment – % of households that earn a basic needs budget

HOUSING

GOAL: Every Household Can Afford Their Housing

Down-payment Assistance - % of known households spending less than 30% of their income on housing

Rent/Utility Assistance - % of known households spending less than 30% of their income on housing

Rent/Utility Subsidies - % of known households spending less than 30% of their income on housing

GOAL: Every Household Can Sustain Their Housing

Emergency Home Repair - % of households that retain their housing for 24-36 months after interventions/assistance

Housing Sustainment Interventions - % of households that retain their housing for 24-36 months after interventions/assistance

HOUSEHOLD STABILIZATION (\$30,000 Maximum Grant)

GOAL: Every Household Has Their Most Basic Needs Met (Output Based)

Food – Number of households served.

Emergency Shelter/Safety – Number of households served.

Crisis Stabilization – Number of households served.
