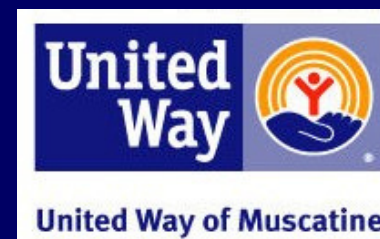
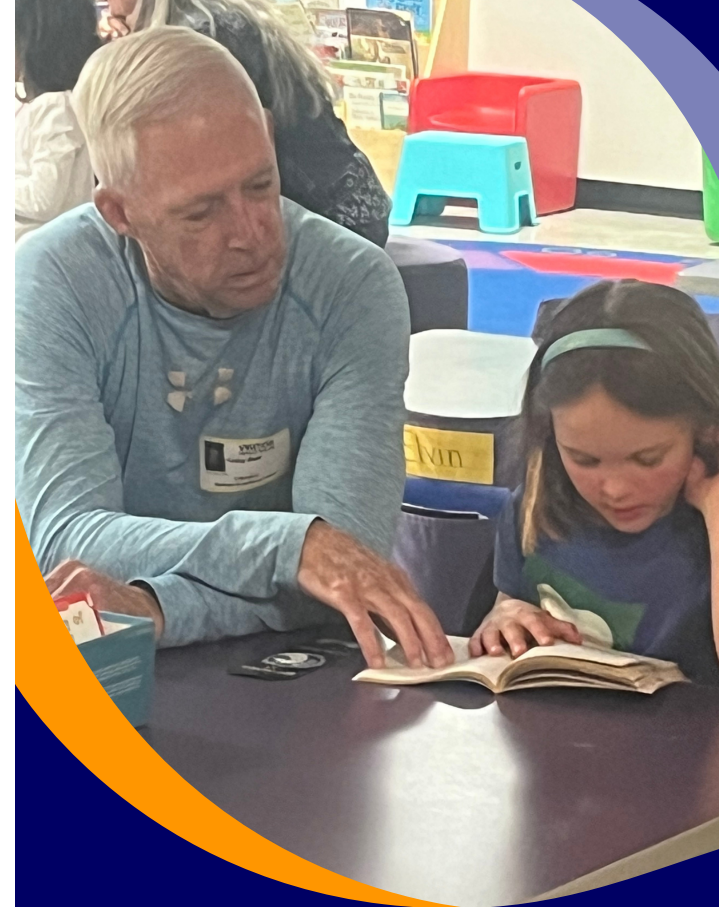

In the last year...

- 1,200 children received age-appropriate books each month through Imagination Library.
- Barriers to education and participation in extracurricular activities were eliminated for 1,453 children.
- 194 people including 58 children were able to access the homeless shelter.
- 298 at-risk prek-6th graders attended after-school programs focused on academic and behavioral improvement.

- 593 people including 250 children were able to avoid homelessness and stay in stable housing.
- 90 at-risk K-6th graders attended after-school programs focused on academic and behavioral improvement.
- 11,174 bags of food were distributed to families in need.
- 313 survivors of domestic and sexual abuse, human trafficking, and other violent crimes were able to receive trauma-informed services including counseling, advocacy and assistance to obtain no-contact orders.

- 9,146 snacks were served to children in after-school programs in Muscatine County.
- Almost \$26,000 worth of items were donated during community-wide drives.
- 120 individuals with special needs participated in Special Olympics programming.
- Approximately 18,000 volunteer hours were logged through the volunteermuscatine.org site, saving approximately \$500,000!
